

Current Policy

ATTENDANCE REQUIREMENTS

501.1

By the adoption of an official school calendar the Board determines the compulsory attendance period for each school year. It shall be the responsibility of the parent to notify school if the student will not be attending on a particular day. Students who are absent without permission are considered truant, which means the student willfully failed to attend school. Truant students will be reported to the appropriate authorities.

Students are ordinarily considered for admission if enrolling on a full-time basis. However, dual enrollment students will be considered for admission in the following classes in Grades 6-8: Band, Choir, and Music.

Expectations for families in this arrangement:

1. Families interested in dual enrollment in the above courses will follow the prescribed school admissions process.
2. Students and families will be expected to abide by school policies detailed in the Board Policy Manual and School Handbooks.
3. Enrollment in the above courses is available on a space available, first come basis. Space available for the upcoming year will be determined by June 1st.
4. It will be the responsibility of parents to make arrangements during modified schedules due to vacation, snow days, field trips, etc.
5. Once a student is enrolled, it is the expectation of the school that the student be enrolled for the entire academic school year. Non-refundable tuition should be paid by the parents prior to the start of the school year, unless arrangements have been made with the Finance Committee.
6. Students will participate in classes, school concerts and programs, and area fine arts events.
7. Parents and teachers should work together on arrival and departure times for the student in ensure continuity. Students who arrive early should wait in the office area. Students who are waiting to be picked up should also wait in the office area.
8. The annual cost of course offerings will use this formula: The cost of tuition for the year divided by 39 (number of periods each day in Grades 6-8) multiplied by the number of class periods the student attends each week. Parents would also be responsible for any applicable fees.
