



## Oskaloosa Christian School SCHOOL SUPPLIES for 2021-2022

### **Kinder Kids: Mrs. Hoksbergen, Mrs. Grafke**

2 plastic pencil boxes (approximately 8.5 x 5.5), girls bring 1 canister of baby wipes, boys bring 1 canister of Clorox wipes, 2 boxes of tissues, 4 low-odor dry erase markers (black), pair of clean socks to use as an eraser, 2 two-pocket folders (bottom pockets work best), 1 backpack, 1 Fiskar scissors, 1 box of Crayola 8 crayons, 1 box of Crayola 24 crayons, 1 box of Crayola 12 colored pencils (not the eraser kind), 8 Elmer's clear dry glue sticks, 1 pair of headphones (no ear buds), tennis shoes for PE (only if your child does not wear them to school), rain boots for fall and spring, snow pants and snow boots for winter, jump rope

### **1st Grade: Mrs. Van Roekel**

24 pack of pencils, 1 box of crayons (any size,) markers, colored pencils, 3-4 large glue sticks, big eraser (pencil top erasers are optional,) 1 pair of quality, pointed scissors, 1 PLASTIC folder any color, 1 letter-sized clipboard, 2 pencil boxes (plastic preferred,) 1 ream wide-ruled lined paper, 2-4 Expo markers and old, clean sock for erasing, ruler with inches/centimeters, Crayola brand watercolor paints, headphones/earbuds, 1 pair of old shoes or boots to wear at recess, 2 boxes of tissues and 1 canister of Clorox wipes, plastic magazine holder (for books), 1 container of baby wipes, jump rope

### **2nd Grade: Miss Graves**

5 pencils (no mechanical, no plastic coating), 2 large erasers, pencil box, wide-ruled notebook, crayons (24 count only, no twist-up), colored pencils, markers, 5 small glue sticks, 12 inch/metric ruler, 1 large box of tissues, scissors, 2 pocket folders (no trapper keeper), 1 9 x 12 clipboard, Crayola brand watercolor paints, 12 low-odor dry erase marker & 1 eraser, 1 dry erase board, 2 Clorox wipes for class, headphones, 1 pkg. notebook paper, jump rope

### **3rd Grade: Mrs. Klucas**

24 plain #2 pencils (no plastic coating), colored pencils, colored markers (optional- small package only), crayons (24 count only), 5 glue sticks, pencil eraser, 5 thin low-odor dry erase markers + 1 eraser/sock, 4 pocket folders (plastic only, one red), 2 pkgs. (100 count) wide-ruled notebook paper, clipboard, earbuds/headphones, 2 large boxes of tissues, watercolor paints, 1" binder, 1 baby wipes, jump rope

### **4th Grade: Mrs. Vander Wal**

12 #2 pencils, colored pens, colored pencils, colored markers, old clean sock, crayons, glue sticks, big eraser, scissors, 4 low-odor dry erase markers, water color paints, clipboard, headphones, 1 Clorox wipes, 1 folder for music, 8 binder dividers with pockets, 1-inch binder (the dividers will go inside of this), jump rope

### **5th Grade: Mrs. Mitchell**

1 container of Clorox wipes, 1 pkg. colored pencils, 4 dry erase markers/cloth for erasing, 2 black sharpie markers, crayons, watercolor paints, earbuds, eraser, Folders: one of each color **with center brads**: -yellow (English), red (Spelling) -purple (Bible), 8 glue sticks, 1 hand-held pencil sharpener (not battery powered), heavy duty scissors, 1 highlighter, ruler - metric and English measures (no folding rulers), 2 pkgs. pencils, 2 boxes of tissues, pencil bag, planner, 1- 1 ½ in. binder for math, jump rope

colored pencils, colored markers, 4 black pens + at least 4 other-colored pens, 2 pkgs. #2 pencils, 4 low-odor dry erase markers, 1 bound notebook or journal, notebook for Music class, 3-hole punched storage folders for each subject (7 folders total), pencil eraser, 2 highlighters, 2 boxes of tissues, one calculator TI 30XIIS (or other calculator with trig functions), planner, earbuds/headphones, 2 pkgs. index cards (**7th and 8th only**), Clorox wipes, organization method choice: 5-subject wide-ruled notebook OR three-ring binder (like a Trapper Keeper) with 2 pkgs. loose-leaf wide-ruled paper OR a backpack, jump rope (Please put names on all supplies!)
