

KNOWLEDGE BOWL! On Tuesday, April 4, five middle school students teamed up to compete in the Knowledge Bowl. The Knowledge Bowl is a competition comprising three rounds of questions. The first round is a written test of forty multiple choice questions which a team must complete in fifteen minutes. The second round is a whiteboard round, where teams receive thirty questions, one at a time, to answer as a team by writing their answer to each question on a whiteboard. The third round is a buzzer round, where two teams of students face off. The student who buzzes in the guickest can answer the question first. This round also has thirty questions.
