REMINDERS



- •Change in Start Time! A reminder that beginning next Monday for the rest of the school year we will be starting school at 8:00 sharp instead of 8:05. Please prepare for this slight change and make every effort to honor teachers by getting your student(s) here on time every day!
- •Students in grades 3-8 will be taking ISASP (Iowa Statewide Assessment of Student Progress) next week Monday through Thursday for approximately 2 hours each morning. Please be sure your children are here and are well rested, and have been fed a good breakfast for this important testing. This testing is required by the state of lowa in order for our families to qualify for receiving ESA funds next year.
- •ESA Applications will be accepted April 16-June 30 through the withodyssey.com website. Due to changes in the Iowa tax forms, you might qualify for ESA funding even if you did not qualify last year. More information was emailed to parents last week.
- •A reminder to families who live outside the Oskaloosa School District: Your mileage reimbursement forms must be turned in to your residing school district by May 1. Extra forms are in the office and can be sent home with students.
