- •Testing Requirements: Parents, for those of you who qualify for the Education Savings Accounts, you may have recently received an email from the lowa Department of Education regarding testing that is required for students in order to qualify for ESAs. We want to assure all OSCI families that our school is following all guidelines for parents to qualify for ESAs. The ISASP (Iowa Statewide Assessment of Student Progress) testing that is required will be done the last week in April, and is in addition to the MAP and DIBELS testing that our school currently has.
