

REMINDERS



•A reminder that if your child will be absent or late for school, please let a teacher or the school office know before 8:00. If we are not able to take your call, please leave a message. Our morning classes begin at 8:05, with the first bell ringing at 8:00. Students arriving after 8:05 will be considered tardy. To provide adequate time for all students to get dropped off and settled into their classroom, all children should arrive to school no later than 7:55. Please make every effort to have your children on time every morning. All students arriving after 8:05 must sign in at the office.

•A reminder that all visitors must sign in at the school office upon arriving. As requested by the school board, ALL VISITORS, IN-**CLUDING PARENTS**, are required to use the west door by the office for entry into the school. Please check in at the office to sign in and receive a visitor's pass. There's no need to sign in if you are only picking up or dropping off your child, but you do need to use the west door.

•IF YOU ARE PICKING UP YOUR CHILDREN FOR A 2:15 DIS-MISSAL, please do not arrive before 2:00! The SONshine Preschool students are dismissed at 2:00, and all vehicles waiting for them will be given the first places in car line. OSCI parents should follow the car line to the east around the bus and stop there, waiting for SONshine parents to load first. Once SONshine students are loaded, they will wave the waiting cars to pull foward. Thank you for your cooperation in making our car line safe and effective.

•There will be no school for Labor Day on Monday, September 4. •A reminder that students who have not been picked up after school by 3:25, (2:25 on Wednesdays) or the end of the carline, will automatically be sent to after-school care and families will be charged the appropriate fee. After-school care is available for any K-8 student on most school days. More information about afterschool care can be found in the Parent Handbook.

Please check the income eligibility guidelines included on the form, and if your family qualifies, please bring your completed form to school next Monday or Tuesday. All forms are kept confidential.

Parents are invited to eat lunch with students this year. Visitor lunches will be \$4.84. Please call or email the Food Service Department before 10:00 on the day you plan to visit so that enough food can be prepared for everyone. IMPORTANT! Attention Parents of ALL grades: Due to students with food allergies, we are asking that parents DO NOT send lunches or snacks that contain fish, peanuts, or tree nuts with their children. Tree nuts include pecans, almonds, cashews, walnuts, hazelnuts (Nutella is a hazelnut product that should be avoided), pine nuts, and other nuts that grow on trees. Please also avoid peanut butter and other peanut products. Items that are processed in a place where nuts are used are acceptable (ex. no peanut M&Ms, but plains, even though produced in the same factory, are OK). Most packaging will indicate such a situation when it occurs. There will be no hot lunches that include these foods served to anyone. If your child has a serious food allergy that is not listed here, please contact the office, your child's teacher, or our Food Service Department. We appreciate everyone's help in keeping our students safe and healthy!
