Upcoming order dates: Dec. 11 (last date to order for Christmas!), Jan. 8


•We are doing 2 national orders per month this year. Order dates will be published in the Crusader Chronicles.

One of the means for us to bless families to have access to a quality Christian education is through the Legacy of Grace School Tuition Organization (LOG-STO). This state program allows for individuals and businesses to donate money to help families with tuition at a private school, receiving a 75% state tax credit of the donation. As an example, if you donate one hundred dollars to the LOG-STO, you will receive a state tax credit of \$75, which reduces your state tax liability. ADVANCE NOTICE: MAP testing will take place January 22-26 for students in 3rd-8th grades. MAP stands for Measures of Academic Progress. MAP testing is an online testing platform that will be given three times

a year so we can not only track progress from year-to-year, but also within a school year, allowing data to be shared with parents during both conference times. We ask that you please not schedule appointments, especially during the mornings of January 22-26. It is important that all students are on time and attend for this important testing. Our first MAP testing was held in September and the final testing will be in May.
