REMINDERS



•There will be no school for Labor Day on Monday, September 4.
•IF YOU ARE PICKING UP YOUR CHILDREN FOR A 2:15 DIS-MISSAL, please do not arrive before 2:00! The SONshine Preschool students are dismissed at 2:00, and all vehicles waiting for them will be given the first places in car line. OSCI parents should follow the car line to the east around the bus and stop there, waiting for SONshine parents to load first. Once SONshine students are loaded, they will wave the waiting cars to pull foward. Thank you for your cooperation in making our car line safe and effective.

•A reminder about medications: Parents, if you are sending medicine to school with your child, please include a note giving us permission to administer it. The note should also include the name of the medicine, the dosage and the time it can be taken. Students must not keep medicines in their desks, backpacks, or lockers, but must bring them to the office, where they can be kept locked up to follow State of lowa regulations. Some considerations are given in the case of inhalers for students with asthma. Reminder: The school does not provide medicines such as Tylenol or cough syrup. All medication is to be provided by parents. Thank you!

UPCOMING TESTING!

- 1) DIBELS testing will be taking place for students in grades K-5 the week of September 18. DIBELS stands for Dynamic Indicators of Basic Early Literacy Skills. It is a reading assessment that Oskaloosa Christian does three times a year to track reading progress. This has been done over the last few years at OSCI, so this is a continuation of a process that is already in place.
- 2) MAP testing will take place the week of September 25. MAP stands for Measures of Academic Progress. MAP testing is an online testing platform that will be given three times a year so we can not only track progress from year-to-year, but also within a school year. Data from this testing will be shared with parents at both conferencing times to show how your student is progressing. We will also be conducting MAP testing in January and April.

Hot Lunch Balance: Parents, please be sure your family's hot lunch account is supplied with adequate funds throughout the year. Your balance can be checked from our school's website under the Parent Resources tab. From there go to Hot Lunch Program, and select the School Lunch Web Account to log in and view your account. Payments must be made by cash or check and can be mailed or brought in to school. Checks should be written to OSCI Food Service. IMPORTANT! Attention Parents of ALL grades: Due to students with food allergies, we are asking that parents DO NOT send lunches or snacks that contain fish, peanuts, or tree nuts with their children. Tree nuts include pecans, almonds, cashews, walnuts, hazelnuts (Nutella is a hazelnut product that should be avoided), pine nuts, and other nuts that grow on trees. Please also avoid peanut butter and other peanut products. Items that are processed in a place where nuts are used are acceptable (ex. no peanut M&Ms, but plains, even though produced in the same factory, are OK). Most packaging will indicate such a situation when it occurs. There will be no hot lunches that include these foods served to anyone. If your child has a serious food allergy that is not listed here, please contact the office, your child's teacher, or our Food Service Department. We appreciate everyone's help in keeping our students safe and healthy!
