

## Legacy of Grace

One of the means for us to bless families to have access to a quality Christian education is through the Legacy of Grace School Tuition Organization (LOG-STO). This state program allows for individuals and businesses to donate money to help families with tuition at a private school, receiving a 75% state tax credit of the donation, which reduces your state tax liability.

Our LOG-STO has been allocated to collect \$559,683.00 this year to help families who are not currently eligible for a State of lowa Education Savings Account. For example, our Transitional Kindergarten students are not eligible because they attend fewer days. A donation of any size would help us to move closer to our goal.
