Enrollment for 2025-2026!



Dear OC parents, enrollment for returning students for the 2025-2026 school year begins today! The enrollment process is similar to last year with a few minor changes. Here are some things to know:

•If you are listed as the parent who has primary financial responsibility, you received an email today from admissions@oskaloosachristian.net giving you instructions.

•An Early Bird Enrollment Fee of \$50 for each student is required. The fee will increase to \$100 on February 15. All returning students are required to be enrolled by February 28, and will reserve a place for them in their classroom.

•If your family has TRIP credit, your balance is listed in FACTS and is available to use for the enrollment fee and for tuition.

•If your child will be riding an Osky Public bus next year, a link will be provided during enrollment to enter your information which will be submitted directly to the Oskaloosa Schools Transportation Department. This must be done for your child to ride their bus, and eliminates the paper bus form that has been required in the past.

TRIP Change: Due to the changes in the enrollment process, the OC Trip Program will be moving the yearly payout to reflect a calendar year instead of its current school year. This means that the TRIP program closed its books for the 2024 year on December 31, 2024, and you should have already received a statement. Your credit earned July 1- December 31 is now available. This means credit can be used for things like Hot Lunch, Band Fees, or Tuition for this current school year, or Enrollment for the 2025-26 school year.
