•CAR LINE SAFETY! Parents, a reminder that when dropping off your children in the morning, please pull ahead to the first available spot. Due to the number of cars that are often waiting in line, a quick and efficient dropoff would be appreciated. And please do NOT pass cars on the left since some students exit their vehicle on the left side! Thank you for your cooperation in making our car lines safe and effective.

•Parent/Teacher Conferences will be held for all grades, TK through 8th, on Thursday, March 13 from 1:00-8:00 pm and Friday, March 14 from 8:30 am - noon. Signup is again being handled through a link to signupgenius.com. This link will be emailed next Tuesday, February 25 to all school parents who have two or more children in TK-8th. It will also be emailed to our parents who have a SONshine Preschool student so that they can sign up for back to back conferences with the SONshine teachers. On Friday, February 28 the link will be emailed to all parents. We are asking ALL families to sign up so that Dibels and Map Testing results can be reviewed. Signup deadline is Wednesday, March 5. Please note that limited conference times will be available for our part-time teachers. If their times do not work for your family, please contact the teachers directly with any concerns or to set up another time with them.

Enrollment for 2025-2026!

Dear OC parents, thanks to all of you who have enrolled your children for next year! The enrollment fee is now \$100. All returning students must be enrolled by February 28 to reserve a place in their classroom.

Here are some things to know:

- •If you are listed as the parent who has primary financial responsibility, you received an email on January 31 from admissions@ oskaloosachristian.net giving you instructions.
- •If your family has TRIP credit, your balance is listed in FACTS and is available to use for the enrollment fee and for tuition.
- •The fee must be paid before enrollment is considered complete. Be sure to 'Review and Submit' the enrollment packet at the end.
- •If your child will be riding an Osky Public bus next year, a link will be provided during enrollment to enter your information which will be submitted directly to the Oskaloosa Schools Transportation Department. This **must be** done for your child to ride their bus, and eliminates the paper bus form that has been required in the past. Note: When signing up for the Osky buses, please enter our school name in the additional comments section at the bottom.
