



SCHOOL SUPPLIES for 2025-2026

Transitional Kindergarten: Mrs. Hoksbergen

Crayola Markers 8-10 count, 2 boxes tissues, 4 low-odor dry erase markers (Black), 2 two-pocket folders (bottom pocket works best), 1 backpack, 1 box of large Crayola 8 crayons, 1 box of Crayola 24 crayons, 8 Elmer's clear dry glue sticks, 1 box snack sized zip lock bags, 1 pair of headphones (no ear buds), jump rope, tennis shoes for PE (only if your child does not wear them to school), rain boots for the fall and spring, snow pants and snow boots for winter.

Please label the following items: Folders, backpack, headphones, and jump rope.

2 plastic pencil boxes (approx. 8.5×5.5), 1 box of tissues, large pack black dry erase markers, pair of clean <u>socks</u> to use as an eraser, 2 two-pocket folders (bottom pockets preferred), 1 backpack (no small ones please), 1 Fiskar scissors, 1 box of 8 Crayola crayons, 1 box of 24 Crayola colored pencils (24 of the non-eraser kind preferred), 2 Elmer's glue sticks, 1 pair of headphones (no ear buds), pair of boots for recess, tennis shoes for PE (if your child does not wear them day to day), jump rope, girls bring Clorox wipes, boys bring baby wipes.

24 pack of pencils, 1 box of crayons (any size,) markers, colored pencils, 4-6 large glue sticks, big eraser (pencil top erasers are optional,) 1 pair of quality, pointed scissors, 1 PLASTIC folder any color, 1 letter-sized clipboard, 2 pencil boxes (plastic preferred), large pkg of Expo markers and old, clean sock for erasing, ruler with inches/centimeters, Crayola brand watercolor paints, no earbuds headphones, 1 pair of boots to wear at recess, 2 boxes of tissues and 1 canister of Clorox wipes, plastic magazine holder (for books), girls bring 1 container of baby wipes, boys bring 1 bottle hand sanitizer, jump rope, <u>oversized</u> t-shirt to be used as paint shirt

24 #2 Ticonderoga pencils, 1 large eraser, 2 pencil boxes, 2 packages of wide ruled notebook paper, 1 spiral notebook, Crayola crayons, colored pencils, markers, 2 highlighters, 6 glue stick (NO SCENTED GLUE), 2 boxes of Kleenex, scissors, (2) 2 pocket folders (1 of them red), Crayola brand water colors, 12 low odor dry erase markers, 1 eraser (an old sock will work), 2 Clorox wipes, headphones, jump rope, girls bring 1 bottle hand sanitizer, boys bring 1 package of baby wipes, PE shoes.
